TELEPHONE AUTHORITY ORDER NO. 558

In the matter of SOUTHMESTERN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY for authority to file and make effective in less than thirty days revised tariffs which will allow the Company to set out municipal license taxes as a separate taxe on the customer's statement for service.

On April 9, 1968, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company submitted for filing proposed tariffs which would allow it to set out city or county frenchise, occupation, business, license, excise, privilege or similar taxes as a separate item on the customer's statement for service. To implement this proposal, the Company will reduce existing rates by an amount equal to or greater than item bighant city or county license tax now assessed for each individual rate group. The tax on each customer's bill will then be computed on a basis of the tax being layied by local authorities in the particular city or county.

The authorization of the proposed tariffs would have the effect of reducing Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's annual revenue by an estimated \$1,125,000. Gross charges for service for a large majority of the Company's containers will be unchanged or will be reduced by the authorization of the proposal.

It is, therefore,

UNDERED: That Southwestern Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby sufficiently to file and make effective in less than thirty (30) days the following tariffs:
