

dissolved may not carry on any business except that necessary to wind up and liquidate its business and affairs.¹

5. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

6. The Company has failed to file annual reports. The requirement of a telecommunications company to file an annual report is identified in Sections 392.210 and 392.390, RSMo and 20 CSR 4240-28.012(1)(A). The company has also failed to file Statement of Revenues. The requirement to file a Statement of Revenue report is identified in 20 CSR 4240-28.012(1)(B). The Company fails to be legally, financially, and technically qualified to provide service due it is dissolution in 2001. Therefore, Staff requests the Commission cancel the certificate to provide IXC service in Missouri .

7. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests a hearing.²

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully recommend the Commission cancel Harcourt Telco, LLC., d/b/a Maverix.net, Inc.’s certificate of authority to provide IXC service in Missouri.
