MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through counsel, and for its *Motion for Extension of Time*, states as follows:

1. On January 5, 2026, Evergy Metro, Inc., d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc., d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (collectively "Evergy") filed tariff sheets to allow its customers to opt out of Time of Use (TOU) rates.

2. Staff has been in productive discussion with Evergy concerning the tariff sheets and requests an additional 10 days in which to file its report and recommendation. That being said, Staff will endeavor to complete its review prior to any newly-established filing date.

3. This Motion is made in the interest of justice and without the intent to unreasonably delay or hinder these proceedings in any manner.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this *Motion for Extension of Time* for the Commission's information and consideration and hereby prays the Commission grant Staff an additional 10 days within which to file its report and recommendation in this matter; and to grant such other and further relief as the Commission considers just and reasonable in the circumstances.
