ORDER DIRECTING RECONCILIATION

Issue Date: January 30, 2026

Effective Date: January 30, 2026

Section 386.420.4, RSMo (2016), requires the Commission to prepare and approve a detailed reconciliation regarding the dollar value and rate or charge impact of the contested issues decided by the Commission in this rate case. The law requires the Commission to allow the parties an opportunity to provide written input regarding that reconciliation. The Commission will order The Empire District Electric Company to file that reconciliation. The Commission will also establish a time for any party to file a written response to the reconciliation if it wishes to do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Empire District Electric Company shall file the reconciliation required by Section 386.420.4, or a request for an extension of time, no later than February 12, 2026.
2. Any party wishing to file a response to the reconciliation shall do so no later than February 19, 2026.
3. This order is effective when issued.
