**MOTION TO CANCEL REGISTRATION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to cancel the registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (“IVoIP”) services in Missouri of Nexogy, Inc., (“Nexogy” or “Company”) and states:

1. On September 30, 2019, the Commission granted Nexogy Inc. a registration to provide IVoIP services in Missouri.<sup>1</sup>

2. On February 04, 2026, Nexogy was administratively dissolved and/or had its registration revoked by the Missouri Secretary of State for failure to comply with § 351.484 RSMo and 351.598 RSMo.<sup>2</sup> Any corporation administratively dissolved may not carry on any business except to wind up and liquidate its affairs under 351.476 RSMo.

3. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate, or in the present case, registration, pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo, which provides “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

4. The Company has failed to file its calendar year 2024 annual report. The requirement of an IVoIP company to file an annual report is identified in

Sections 392.550.3(7), RSMo and 20 CSR 4240-28.012(1)(A). The Company has also failed to file its 2024 statement of revenue report and pay the Missouri Commission annual assessment for fiscal year 2026.<sup>3</sup> The requirement to file a Statement of Revenue report is identified in 20 CSR 4240-28.012(1)(B). The requirement to pay the Missouri Commission assessment is identified in Section 386.370, RSMo and 20 CSR 4240-28.012(2)(A). The Company fails to be legally, financially, and technically qualified to provide service because the corporation has been administratively dissolved and/or revoked. Therefore, Staff requests the Commission cancel the registration to provide IVOIP services in Missouri.

5. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests a hearing.<sup>4</sup>

**WHEREFORE**, Staff respectfully recommend the Commission cancel of Nexogy Inc.'s registration to provide IVolP services in Missouri.
