MOTION TO CANCEL REGISTRATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to cancel PCI, Inc. d/b/a PCI, Incorporated of Tennessee’s (“PCI”) registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (IVoIP) service within the state of Missouri and states:

1. On July 22, 2024, in Commission File No. DA-2025-0006, the Commission granted PCI with registration to provide IVoIP services within the state of Missouri.
2. On February 4, 2026, PCI was administratively dissolved or revoked by the Missouri Secretary of State for failure to file a registration report. As such, PCI is not authorized to carry out any business other than that which is necessary to wind up and liquidate its business and affairs under Section 351.476, RSMo.
3. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate, or in the present case, registration, pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo which provides “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

4. PCI failed to pay the Commission annual assessment for fiscal year 2026.¹

The requirement to pay the Commission assessment is identified in Section 386.370, RSMo and Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-28.012(2)(A).

5. In light of the fact that PCI has 1). been administratively dissolved; and 2). failed to pay the Commission assessment fees for fiscal year 2026, it is not legally, financially, or technically qualified to provide service in the state of Missouri. Therefore, Staff respectfully recommends the Commission cancel PCI's registration to provide IVoIP services in Missouri.

6. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests a hearing.²

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully recommends the Commission cancel PCI's registration to provide IVoIP services in Missouri.

If a company fails to file a Statement of Revenue Report then the company's assessment is calculated using a Commission approved formula.
