ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

Issue Date: March 13, 2026

On March 13, 2026, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting the Commission cancel the certificates of COMTECH 21, LLC to provide intrastate interexchange, non-switched local exchange, and basic local telecommunications services. The Commission granted COMTECH 21, LLC a certificate to provide intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in Case No. TA-2001-666. The Commission granted COMTECH 21, LLC a certificate to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services in Case No. CA-2004-0393.

Staff's motion states that COMTECH 21, LLC failed to file an annual report or statement of revenue for calendar years 2023 and 2024; and failed to pay the Commission assessment for fiscal years 2025 and 2026. The requirements of telecommunication companies under Sections 392.210 and 392.390, RSMo, include filing an annual report and a Statement of Revenue.

Subsection 392.410(5), RSMo provides the Commission authority to alter or modify any telecommunications certificate of service after notice and hearing. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may revoke the telecommunications certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to respond or file a motion for hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Anyone wishing to respond to Staff's motion or request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than March 23, 2026.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
