ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

Issue Date: March 24, 2026

Effective Date: April 3, 2026

On March 13, 2026, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting that the Commission cancel the certificates of COMTECH 21, LLC to provide intrastate interexchange, non-switched local exchange, and basic local telecommunications services. The Commission granted COMTECH 21, LLC a certificate to provide intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in Case No. TA-2001-666. COMTECH 21, LLC has a currently effective IXC tariff, Tracking No. JL-2002-0280. The Commission granted COMTECH 21, LLC a certificate to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services in Case No. CA-2004-0393.

Staff's motion states that COMTECH 21, LLC failed to file an annual report or statement of revenue for calendar years 2023 and 2024; and failed to pay the Commission assessment for fiscal years 2025 and 2026. The requirements of telecommunication companies under Sections 392.210 and 392.390, RSMo, include filing an annual report and a statement of revenue.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which provides “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing...” The Commission issued notice and allowed time to request a hearing. No responses were received.

Based on COMTECH 21, LLC’s failure to pay its annual assessment, failure to file annual reports and statements of revenue, and because COMTECH 21, LLC has not requested a hearing or otherwise responded, the Commission finds that the certificates of service authority granted to it shall be cancelled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of service authority issued in Case No. TA-2001-666 to COMTECH 21, LLC to provide intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services telecommunications service in the state of Missouri is cancelled.
2. The IXC tariff of COMTECH 21, LLC, Tracking No. JL-2002-0280, is cancelled.
3. The certificate of service authority issued in Case No. CA-2004-0393 to COMTECH 21, LLC to provide basic local exchange telecommunications service in the state of Missouri is cancelled.
4. This order shall become effective on April 3, 2026.
5. This case shall be closed on April 4, 2026.

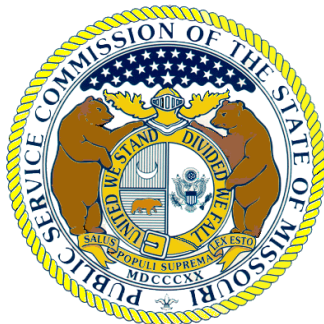
