

of this reporting be transmitted, with appropriate safeguards for confidential information, as part of the integrated resource planning (IRP) process, to appropriate stakeholders. Renew offers this could be accomplished by including this information in minimum filing requirements under the proposed IRP rule, 20 CSR 4240-21.025 Standards and Dataset Management Requirements, and will proffer that suggestion in that upcoming docket as well.

Additionally, Renew supports the comments of Ameren Missouri in regard to adding a definition and further clarity around “contracted resources”. Utilities quite often enter into contracts for capacity and purchased power, and current conditions could make such contracts more attractive for utilities to enter into. Therefore, Renew believe including the clarifications Ameren Missouri requests and suggests regarding a definition for “contracted resources” and the reporting form Exhibit 6 will help ensure the information provided is helpful and clear.

WHEREFORE, Renew respectfully submits its comments on the proposed SRM rule for the Commission’s consideration and inclusion.
