

In the Wildfire Plan Order, the Commission directed electrical corporations to provide Commission Staff (1) a final draft copy of their wildfire mitigation and preparedness plans no later than December 31, 2026; and (2) quarterly updates on the development of their wildfire mitigation and preparedness plans, with the first update due no later than March 31, 2026. The Wildfire Plan Order included a series of minimum expectations and components that must be included in electrical corporations' wildfire mitigation and preparedness plans. ITC Midwest is currently reviewing ITC Holding Corp.'s current policies and procedures concerning public safety, wildfire mitigation, and emergency preparedness to ensure ITC Midwest's compliance with the Wildfire Plan Order.
