2025 YEARLY METER TESTING REPORT

COMES NOW The Empire District Gas Company (“EDG” or the “Company”) and respectfully provides its 2025 Yearly Meter Testing Report to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) pursuant to the Commission’s *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement, Granting Variance, and Granting Waiver* (“*Approval Order*”) issued in the above-captioned matter on August 2, 2023, effective August 12, 2023, regarding the Company’s meter testing pilot program.

1. The requirements for the contents of a yearly report to be filed by EDG are set out on page three of the *Approval Order* and are set forth below:

- a. number of remaining meters required to be tested to complete catch-up program;
- b. summary of test results by Group as defined by in the Application appendix C (as amended);
- c. description of any impacts to annual meter testing target, including but not limited to supply-chain issues, internal constraints, and third-party testing;
- d. number of letters sent to customers offering courtesy inspections; and,
- e. number of courtesy inspections completed.

2. EDG’s 2025 Yearly Report contains the required information pursuant to the *Approval Order*, including the below information.

- a. The number of remaining meters required to be tested to complete the catch-up program is 1,485.

- b. The summary of test results by Group is shown in “Attachment 1_2025 Catchup meter exchange test results 4-30-26.pdf.”
- c. Regarding the description of any impacts to annual meter testing target, including but not limited to supply-chain issues, internal constraints, and third-party testing: staffing limitations impacted annual meter testing targets in 2025.
- d. The number of letters sent to customers offering courtesy inspections is 1,027.
- e. The number of courtesy inspections completed in 2025 is 6.

WHEREFORE, Liberty respectfully submits its 2025 Yearly Meter Testing Report pursuant to the Commission’s *Approval Order*. No action on the part of the Commission is requested at this time.
