**STATUS REPORT AND MOTION TO EXTEND SUSPENSION OF
PROCEEDINGS**

PCI Inc. d/b/a PCI, Incorporated of Tennessee’s (“PCI”), pursuant to this Commission’s March 24, 2026, *Order Granting Motion to Suspend Proceedings and Direct Filing of Status Report*, and for its Motion to Extend Suspension of Proceedings respectfully states as follow:

1. Counsel for Staff and Counsel for PCI have been in discussions regarding Staff’s Motion to Cancel Registration (“Motion”).
2. Since the filing of this case, PCI submitted payment of its FY 2026 assessment fee, in the amount of \$64.01, on March 19, 2026.
3. In subsequent conversations with Staff, Staff also identified that PCI has failed to file its 2025 Statement of Revenue, due March 31, 2026 and its 2025 Annual Report, due April 15, 2026. PCI is currently working with Staff to resolve these issues as well and the 2024 Annual Report deficiency issue.
4. PCI in still in the process of renewing its registration with the Missouri Secretary of State – due to circumstances outside of its control. DOR’s online portal for obtaining a tax clearance electronically was returning a “system error” and PCI’s CPA passed away in April. Despite such circumstances, PCI is working diligently to complete the appropriate paperwork, so all issues are resolved.
5. PCI requests that the Commission further suspend this case

pending the resolution of those issues and order PCI to file a Status Report in approximately 30 days.

6. Staff does not object to PCI's request.

7. This request is in the interest of justice and to conserve the time and resources of the Parties and of the Commission. This is not intended for the purposes of harassment, vexation, or undue delay in resolving this matter.

WHEREFORE, PCI respectfully requests that the Commission suspend this case and order PCI to file a status report in June 2026.
