## Record of Clarification

COMES NOW the Complainants, Brett Felber and Lisa Lambert, and for their Record of Clarification respectfully state as follows:

1. Complainants proceed to update the record and clarify that any and all outstanding payment agreements entered into between Ameren Missouri and Brett Felber have been fully satisfied well prior to the arranged twelve (12) month payment agreement period.
2. The total balance subject to the payment agreement was in the amount of \$ [REDACTED].
