On June 4, 2026 Evergy responded to the May 20, 2026 email and it is attached to this filing.

The response states, "The project design is nearing completion." Yet, Evergy is placing poles upon my land as a company preference/want.

The response is vague and fails to answer all concerns raised and questions asked. We encountered this previously with Evergy. The information does not support the claim of an NESC requirement.

The 8.7 mile *Fayetteville Transmission Upgrades* project has been ongoing since before December 2023. Evergy's first 'Commission-ordered' Status Report on the ongoing project was filed June 14, 2024, <https://efis.psc.mo.gov/Case/FilingDisplay/593533>

The Commission as a standard for all Electric utilities requires all to adhere to NESC standards. In CCN 9470 the Commission has ordered Evergy to utilize NESC standards. Evergy has seemingly determined the NESC standards are insufficient and Evergy is applying additional clearances which are not needed per the NESC.

Good afternoon, Ms. Hill,

Per my voice mail I left you, earlier this afternoon, below are the answers to your previously asked questions.

Again, I am sincerely sorry you did not receive these sooner. I did have these and misunderstood that I was to send them to you.

Ms. Hill -

1. Purpose of the Requested Easement Width

The requested easement width is necessary to ensure the transmission line can be constructed, operated, and maintained in compliance with applicable safety and clearance requirements. This includes providing adequate space for line movement during weather events and maintaining safe clearances.

2. Alignment Relative to MoDOT Right of Way

MoDOT has indicated that Evergy may utilize the outer edge of its right of way for pole placement. However, this area alone is not sufficient to meet applicable safety and clearance requirements. As a result, additional easement is required on your property to maintain compliance and to ensure we have the ability to control obstructions that could otherwise interfere with the line and create non-compliant or unsafe conditions.

3. Applicable Code Requirements

The design of all projects is based on the clearance and safety requirements established in Section 23 of the National Electrical Safety Code (NESC), which governs minimum clearances and related design considerations for overhead electric lines. Our design has been developed to meet these requirements under a range of operating and environmental conditions.

4. Design Status

The project design is nearing completion. One remaining step is completing "pot-holing" surveys at the proposed pole locations. Access to the property is needed to perform this work and confirm that the planned structure locations are suitable, but the overall design and centerline has been established. Final design details will be confirmed following completion of the "pot-holing" which is done to ensure that we don't interfere with any underground obstacles
