## NOTICE OF ADMITTED AND FILED EXHIBITS

On April 8, 2021, the Commission conducted an evidentiary hearing in the matter of the application of Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) for a certificate of convenience and necessity to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system in and around Hallsville, Missouri. MAWC's application seeks Commission authority to acquire the City of Hallsville sewer system. Boone County Regional Sewer District (District), the Staff of the Commission (Staff) and the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) are also parties.

Consistent with the Commission's April 2, 2021 *Procedural Order Regarding Exhibits*, the parties provided to the regulatory law judge and all other parties exhibit lists and pre-marked proposed exhibits before the hearing.<sup>1</sup> During the hearing, one additional exhibit was circulated among the parties and admitted to the record, to be filed after the hearing: MAWC Exhibit 8.
