ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE EXPEDITED RECOMMENDATION AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR OTHER PARTIES TO OFFER RECOMMENDATIONS

On December 12, 2012, the Commission issued a report and order that rejected Ameren Missouri's tariff to increase the company's annual revenues from its provision of electric service. However, the Commission authorized Ameren Missouri to file a tariff sufficient to recover revenues as determined in that report and order. Ameren Missouri filed its compliance tariff on December 17.

Ameren Missouri's compliance tariff carries a 30-day effective date that would put the tariff in effect on January 16, 2013. However, Ameren Missouri filed a motion along with its tariff asking the Commission to expedited its consideration of the compliance tariff and to approve the tariff to go into effect on January 2, which is the date to which the Commission suspended Ameren Missouri's initial rate increase tariff filing.

The Commission will order its Staff to file an expedited recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's compliance tariff, and will establish a date by which other interested parties may file a recommendation regarding that tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's compliance tariff, Tariff No. YE-2013-0269, no later than December 24, 2012.

2. Any other party wishing to file a recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's compliance tariff, Tariff No. YE-2013-0269, shall do so no later than December 24, 2012.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
