ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS

On February 3, 2012, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a tariff designed to increase its annual revenues for electric service. The Commission suspended that tariff and established February 23 as the deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene.

On February 3, Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers applied to intervene. Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) is a Missouri corporation and its members are large industrial customers of Ameren Missouri.¹ More than ten days have passed since MIEC applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that MIEC's interest in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MIEC to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, is granted.
2. This order shall become effective on February 15, 2012.
