SECOND ORDER MODIFYING THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 20, 2021, The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) filed a motion to modify the procedural schedule to hold an additional technical conference with the goal of reaching a settlement. Empire represented that it was requesting the modification with the consent of all parties. The proposed modifications move the dates for the evidentiary hearing from Jun 22, 2021, and June 23, 2021, to mid-August. The Commission will grant Empire's request, but will alter the date rebuttal testimony is due, because July 5, 2021, is a state holiday and some rebuttal testimony will be filed by the Commission's Staff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The remaining procedural schedule is modified to provide as follows:

Evidentiary Hearing	August 19-20, 2021

2. The additional procedural requirements contained in the Commission's March 3, 2021, Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Other Procedural Requirements, not specifically modified by this order, remain effective.

3. The evidentiary hearing set for June 22, 2021, and June 23, 2021, is cancelled.

4. This order is effective when issued.
