MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and for its *Motion to Consolidate* in this matter, states as follows:

1. On June 12, 2026, Staff filed a motion to open an investigatory docket into S.K. & M. Water and Sewer Company (“S. K. & M.”). As Staff’s investigation involves both matters pertaining to water service and sewer service, the investigatory docket was bifurcated and assigned both water and sewer case designations. The cases were assigned Case Nos. WO-2026-0360 and SO-2026-0361.

2. S. K. & M. is the sole subject of investigation in both cases. Staff’s investigation will be on both water and sewer service provided by S. K. & M. and arise out of customer complaints and Staff concerns which surfaced during the investigation of those complaints. Thus, the cases reference the same subject matter, will involve similar parties, and will contain common questions of law and fact. Consolidation of Case Nos. WO-2026-0360 and SO-2026-0361 would therefore promote administrative efficiency for filings and discovery.

3. Pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.110(3), the Commission may issue orders concerning pending cases to avoid unnecessary costs or delays if the actions

involve related questions of law or fact.¹ Staff requests the Commission consolidate the above-captioned cases, designating WO-2026-0360 as the lead case.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this Motion and prays that the Commission will issue an order consolidating Case Nos. WO-2026-0360 and SO-2026-0361, designating WO-2026-0360 as the lead case; and grant such other and further relief as the Commission deems just in the circumstances.
