APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

COME NOW Public Water Supply District Nos. 1 and 2 of Andrew County, Public Water Supply District No. 1 of DeKalb County, and Public Water Supply District of No 1 of Buchanan County ("Water Districts"), and Great Northwest Wholesale Water Commission (collectively referred to as "Sales For Resale Intervenors"), pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.075 and the Commission's *Order Directing Notice Of Contested Case, Establishing Intervention Deadline, And Directing A Proposed Procedural Schedule, Suspending Tariff Sheets, Delegating Authority, and Directing Responses* issued on July 2, 2026, file their Application to Intervene in the above-referenced matter and respectfully state as follows:

1. The Water Districts are each a political subdivision of the State of Missouri organized and existing pursuant to Chapter 247, RSMo, and their legal names and contact information follow:

3. The Great Northwest Wholesale Water Commission (“GNWC”) is a joint municipal utility commission formed under Section 393.700 RSMo and is a wholesale provider of water. GNWC operates a water transmission line along U.S. Highway 36 and Missouri Highway 33 with associated storage and pumping facilities from St. Joseph to Cameron and Maysville, Missouri. 5. The Sales For Resale Intervenors do not have any pending actions or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against them as contemplated by 20 CSR 4240-

2.060(1)(K), nor do the Sales For Resale Intervenors have any annual reports or assessment fees that are overdue.

6. The Sales For Resale Intervenors are customers of Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC" or "water company") and purchase water from said water company for distribution and resale to their own customers.

7. The interests of the Sales For Resale Intervenors are different from that of the general public. Accordingly, the Sales For Resale Intervenors have an interest in this proceeding which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Sales For Resale Intervenors' expertise in this area will assist the Commission in resolving this matter and their intervention will serve the public interest.

8. No other party to this proceeding can adequately represent the Sales For Resale Intervenors' interests.

9. The Sales For Resale Intervenors are still reviewing information submitted by MAWC regarding the various issues in this case and have not determined their positions at this time.
