ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES AND EXTENDING THE TIME FOR TEST YEAR RESPONSES AND A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: July 22, 2026

Effective Date: July 22, 2026

On July 1, 2026, the Missouri-American Water Company (Missouri-American) filed motions to consolidate these rate cases and establish a test year.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.110(3) permits the Commission to consolidate cases that involve related questions of law or fact. These cases involve the same core parties and have similar facts and questions of law.

Section 393.150.3 RSMo, provides that, beginning July 1, 2026, water corporations may request a future test year. Missouri-American has requested to use a future test year consisting of the 12 months ending May 31, 2028.

The Commission set a deadline of July 21, 2026, for the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule and for any responses to Missouri-American's proposed consolidation and future test year. On July 21, 2026, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion for an extension of time. Staff requests that the parties have until August 3, 2026, to file a proposed

procedural schedule and respond to Missouri-American's future test year.

Therefore, the Commission will consolidate these cases and extend the time for the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule and respond to Missouri-American's future test year.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Case No. SR-2026-0305 is consolidated into Case No. WR-2026-0304, with Case No. WR-2026-0304 being the lead case.
2. The parties shall file a joint proposed procedural schedule no later than August 3, 2026.
3. Any responses to Missouri-American's proposed future test year are due no later than August 3, 2026.
4. This order is effective when issued.
