ORDER DIRECTING STAFF REVIEW

On June 24, 2026, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement Regarding Acquisition of Assets and Granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* (Order) approving the application of Missouri-American Water Company (Missouri-American) to acquire the water and sewer systems of the City of Neosho, Missouri.¹

On August 3, 2026, Missouri-American filed tariff sheets purporting to be in compliance with the Commission's Order. Those tariff sheets were assigned Tracking Nos. JW-2027-0018 and JS-2027-0019 and have an effective date of September 2, 2026.

The Commission will direct the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to review the tariff sheets and provide its recommendation. The Commission will also set a time for other

responses.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than August 17, 2026, Staff shall file a recommendation as directed in the body of this order.
2. No other party is required to respond, but any party that wishes to respond to the tariff filings shall do so no later than August 17, 2026
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
