ORDER APPROVING FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE TRUE-UP

Issue Date: February 11, 2015

Effective Date: March 1, 2015

On December 30, 2014, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) submitted an application containing its Fuel Adjustment Clause (“FAC”) true-up filing. GMO identified the amounts over-recovered during the twelfth recovery period (September 1, 2013 through May 31, 2014).

The Commission’s rule regarding fuel adjustment clauses requires the Commission’s Staff to examine the information submitted by GMO and to submit a recommendation within 30 days.¹ Staff filed its recommendation on January 29, 2015. Based on its examination and analysis of information filed by GMO, including the direct testimony of Linda Nunn, and supporting schedules, Staff recommends the Commission approve GMO’s true-up filing amounts of \$36,639 over-recovery from customers in the company’s MPS rate district, and an over-recovery of \$89,760 from customers in its L&P rate district.

The true-up over-recovery amounts are included in GMO’s FAC filing for the accumulation period of June 1, 2014 through November 30, 2014, which is currently before the Commission in File No. ER-2015-0154.

More than ten days have passed since Staff filed its recommendation. No party has filed a response to the recommendation. Based on the direct testimony of Linda Nunn, as well as the uncontested recommendation of Staff, the Commission will approve GMO's true-up filing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's true-up filing for the twelfth recovery period (September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014) is approved.
2. This order shall be effective on March 1, 2015.
3. This file shall be closed on March 2, 2015.
