## ORDER APPROVING WEATHER NORMALIZATION ADJUSTMENT RIDER TARIFF SHEET

Issue Date: August 20, 2026

Effective Date: September 1, 2026

On July 1, 2026, Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire filed proposed revisions to its Weather Normalization Adjustment Rider (WNAR) tariff sheets, assigned Tracking Number JG-2027-0003. The tariff sheets bear an effective date of September 1, 2026.

The purpose of the WNAR tariff sheet is to adjust revenues, either positive or negative, for differences between actual heating degree days and normal heating degree days. The WNAR is the measurement of the gas usage response of the residential customers to weather. The tariff sheets filed are a mandatory annual rate filing to adjust Spire's revenue to account for the effects of abnormal weather. The rate adjustment will be effective for a period of 12 months.

On July 29, 2026, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation and memorandum concerning Tracking No. JG-2027-0003. Staff determined there were

discrepancies with a tariff sheet and requested Spire to submit revised tariff sheets.<sup>1</sup> Spire declined and requested Staff to submit the errors as part of its recommendation instead. Spire subsequently filed a response indicating it agreed with the adjustments recommended by Staff and requested that the Commission reject Tracking No. JG-2027-0003 and order it to submit corrected tariff sheets.

On July 31, 2026, Spire filed corrected tariff sheets, assigned Tracking No. JG-2027-0016, with an effective date of September 1, 2026.

Staff reviewed the tariff sheets assigned Tracking No. JG-2027-0016 as well as the corresponding workpapers and weather data, and recommended approval of the tariff sheets. Staff stated that the average Spire East residential customer will have a decrease of approximately \$0.37 per month, but the average Spire West residential customer will have an increase of approximately \$2.85 per month. No other parties responded.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation and memorandum and finds that the tariff sheets assigned Tracking No. JG-2027-0016 should be approved. To allow the tariff sheets to become effective on the date requested, the Commission finds it reasonable that this order shall go into effect in less than 30 days.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The tariff sheets filed by Spire on July 1, 2026, and assigned Tracking No. JG-2027-0003 are rejected.

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<sup>1</sup> The discrepancies were transposed numbers for Spire East residential Interest on the True-up Amount and weather data which impacted the residential Sum of Monthly Weather Revenue Adjustments.

2. The tariff sheets filed by Spire on July 31, 2026, and assigned Tracking No. JG-2027-0016 are approved to become effective on September 1, 2026, as follows:
