STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), through the undersigned counsel, and for its *Staff Report and Recommendation*, respectfully states as follows:

1. On May 19, 2026, Spire Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Spire (“Spire” or “the Company”) filed an application to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS), and on August 26, 2026, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge* rejecting the previously filed tariff sheet authorizing Spire to submit a tariff sheet in compliance with its *Order*.

2. On August 27, 2026, Spire filed a tariff sheet purported to be in compliance with that *Order* which carried an effective date of September 25, 2026, assigned tracking no. JG-2027-0029. Spire requested expedited treatment to allow the tariff sheet to become effective on September 7, 2026.

3. On August 27, 2026, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Staff Recommendation on Compliance Tariff and Shortening Time for Responses* directing Staff to file its recommendation regarding Spire’s revised tariff sheet (Tracking No. JG-2027-0029) no later than September 2, 2026.

4. Staff reviewed Spire Missouri’s tariff sheet and finds the submitted revised tariff sheet complies with the Commission’s August 26th *Order*.

5. Staff does not oppose Spire Missouri’s request for expedited treatment to the extent the Commission approves a tariff effective date of September 7, 2026. However, the Staff

recommends that there be at least 10 days between the issue date and the effective date of the Commission's Order approving the compliance tariff.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, Staff recommends the Commission issue an order that approves Spire Missouri's August 27, 2026, ISRS tariff sheet:

Eleventh Revised Sheet No 12 / Replacing Tenth Revised Sheet No. 12

with an effective date of September 25, 2026, or sooner; allowing for 10 days between the issue and effective date for the Commission's Order approving the compliance tariff, and for such other orders the Commission finds just and reasonable under the circumstances.

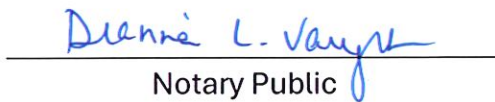
