ORDER ESTABLSIHING RESPONSE DEADLINE

On September 28, 2011, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire") submitted a tariff designed to implement a general rate increase for electric service. The Commission issued notice and set an intervention deadline. The Midwest Energy Users' Association ("MEUA")¹ filed a timely application to intervene; however, Empire has opposed the manner in which MEUA members have sought intervention. The prehearing conference is rapidly approaching and MEUA members will need to know their party status. Consequently, the Commission will set an expedited deadline for MEUA to respond.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. No later than October 29, 2010, the Midwest Energy Users' Association shall respond to The Empire District Electric Company's suggestions in opposition to its application to intervene.

¹ MEUA is an unincorporated ad-hoc association of large commercial and industrial users of electricity, and for purposes of this application MEUA participants include Praxair, Inc., Explorer Pipeline Company and Enbridge Energy, L.L.P.
