## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On July 25, 2011, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri"), submitted an application and tariff designed to implement an adjustment to its Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment Clause. On August 16, 2011, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers ("MIEC") filed its "Motion for FAC Credits from Off-System Sales Margins. On August 24, 2011, the Commission's Staff filed its recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff, which does not appear to address the issues raised in MIEC's motion.

The Commission assumes that Ameren Missouri intends to respond to MIEC's motion, but it is unclear if Staff intends to file a response within the ordinary ten-day response period, i.e. by August 26, 2011. To ensure the Commission is fully informed about the issues raised by MIEC prior to making a decision on Ameren Missouri's tariff, the Commission will direct its Staff to respond.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff shall respond to the MIEC's "Motion for FAC Credits from Off-System Sales Margins" no later than August 29, 2011. Staff's response shall also address any response to MIEC's motion filed by Ameren Missouri.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
