**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTIONS TO STRIKE
PORTIONS OF THE TESTIMONY OF MANTLE AND DAUPHINAIS**

On September 11, 2012, Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to strike the portions of the surrebuttal testimony of Staff witness Lena Mantle and MIEC witness James Dauphinais relating to Midwest ISO transmission charges. Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to rule on its motion by September 14 so that the parties will have an opportunity to prepare for the hearing that begins on September 24. The Commission will promptly rule on Ameren Missouri's motion, but before doing so will allow Staff and MIEC an opportunity to respond.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff and the MIEC shall respond to Ameren Missouri's Motion to Strike Surrebuttal Testimony of Lena Mantle and James R. Dauphinais Regarding Treatment of Midwest ISO Transmission Charges, and Alternative Motion for Leave to File Sur-Surrebuttal Testimony and Motion for Expedited Treatment no later than 1:00 p.m. on September 13, 2012.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
