On February 3, 2012, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, submitted proposed tariff sheets designed to implement a general rate increase for retail electric service. In its February 6 order suspending that tariff, the Commission directed the parties to file recommendations regarding the times, dates, and locations for local public hearings. The Commission also ordered the parties to file proposed language to be included in the notice that will inform the public of those local public hearings.

On March 13, the parties filed a proposed procedural schedule asking the Commission to schedule local public hearings in various locations around Ameren Missouri's service territory. That agreement also includes proposed language to be included in the notice to be given to Ameren Missouri's customers regarding the local public hearings and the evidentiary hearing.

The Commission will schedule local public hearings at locations around Ameren Missouri's service area. The agreed upon notice language is acceptable and Ameren Missouri will be directed to provide notice of the hearings to its customers.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make an informational presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the beginning of each local public hearing.

2. Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall each prepare a one-page statement outlining their current assessment of the case, and shall bring sufficient copies for distribution at the question-and-answer session that begins each local public hearing.

3. Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer session.

4. Any other party, at its discretion, may prepare a statement and make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question and answer session.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Ameren Missouri has filed revised tariff sheets with the Missouri Public Service Commission that are designed to increase the company's electric service revenues by approximately \$376 million. For the average residential customer the proposed increase would be approximately 14 percent or \$14.00 per month. Ameren Missouri's rate filing includes a request to continue its fuel adjustment clause that reflects changes in the cost of fuel used to generate electricity on customers' bills through a separately-identified surcharge or credit outside a general rate case.

21. Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, shall place advertisements in the newspapers serving its service territory. The advertisements shall contain the information from the customer notice relevant to the customers in the newspaper's circulation area.

22. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
