- 2. A list of the current Code Administrator(s) who can provide assistance in completing this form is available upon request from NANPA.
- 3. The NXX field is required for any code request in which there is a change or the NXX is being returned.
- 4. Operating Company Number (OCN) assignments must uniquely identify the applicant. Relative to CO Code assignments, NECA-assigned Company Codes may be used as OCNs. Companies with no prior CO Code or Company Code assignments may contact NECA (973-884-8355) to be assigned a Company Code(s). Since multiple OCNs and/or Company Codes may be associated with a given company, companies with prior assignment should direct questions regarding appropriate OCN usage to the Traffic Routing Administration (TRA) on 732-699-6700.
