FOR SUBMISSION OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS**

On October 1, 2014, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed its 2014 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP), which is required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning rule, 4 CSR 240-22. The purpose of the IRP is to ensure that investor-owned electric utilities, such as Ameren Missouri, consider all options, including demand side efficiency and energy management measures, so as to provide safe, reliable and efficient electric service to the public at reasonable rates, in a manner that serves the public interest.

As required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(6), the Commission will give notice of Ameren Missouri's filing to potentially interested parties, and will set a date for the filing of requests to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's service area and to the members of the General Assembly representing Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's service area.

2. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than October 21, 2014. Such applications shall be filed with:
