ORDER CANCELLING DISCOVERY CONFERENCE

On August 4, 2021, the Commission issued its *Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Other Procedural Requirements*. That order set a Discovery Conference for August 19, 2021.

That order also stated that not less than two business days before each discovery conference, any party that has a discovery concern shall file a brief statement describing that concern. Finally, that order states that if no party identifies any discovery concerns before the scheduled conference, the presiding officer may cancel that conference.

There are currently no discovery disputes requiring a discovery conference and the scheduled discovery conference is less than two business days away. Thus, the discovery conference is cancelled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The August 19, 2021, discovery conference is cancelled.
2. This order is effective when issued.
