ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTIONS

On June 30, 2006, Ozark Energy Partners, LLC filed an application as described in the caption of this order. Thereafter, applications to intervene were filed by Missouri Gas Energy, Southern Star Central Gas Pipeline, Inc., and Alliance Gas Energy Corporation. All proposed intervenors state that they have an interest in this matter that is different from that of the general public in that Ozark seeks to provide service in areas in which the proposed intervenors have an interest. There is no opposition to the applications to intervene.

Interventions are governed by Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.075, which states that the Commission may grant intervention if the proposed intervenor has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order of the Commission arising from the case. The Commission finds that the proposed intervenors have satisfied the Commission's rule and will grant the requested relief.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Alliance Gas Energy Partners Corporation's application to intervene is granted.
2. Missouri Gas Energy's application to intervene is granted.
3. Southern Star Central Gas Pipeline, Inc.'s application to intervene is granted.
4. This order shall become effective on August 15, 2006.
