On September 20, 2007, Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company (MGE) applied for a certificate of convenience and necessity to expand its existing service area to serve a proposed ethanol plant in Carroll County, Missouri. On January 2, 2008, MGE filed a notice dismissing its application.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits an applicant to voluntarily dismiss its application without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered. No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that MGE
