Dear Mr. Crane:

MoKan Dial, Inc. is in receipt of your letter of September 3, 1999.

MoKan Dial, Inc. does have switched terminating access tariffs in place, which apply to the traffic invoiced. The invoices sent Aerial were pursuant to the Missouri Public Service Commission order. Whether this traffic terminated was handed off to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company pursuant to wireless interconnection tariff or pursuant to interconnection agreement, it is your responsibility to pay for this traffic.

Aerial has knowingly handed off to SWB traffic destined for MoKan exchanges despite a contractual obligation not to do so before making arrangements to pay MoKan for use made of facilities prior to obtaining an interconnection agreement.

MoKan is willing to enter into interconnection agreement negotiations, but only Aerial can initiate this process by making such a request. If you desire to commence this process, please begin by letting MoKan know where Aerial would like to directly interconnect its physical facilities with those of MoKan.

MoKan agrees that the federal law requires us to negotiate a direct physical interconnection with Aerial for the reciprocal exchange of intra-MTA traffic. However the law, FCC rules and FCC Orders are clear that a direct physical interconnection is required. Reciprocal compensation for transport and termination does not apply to traffic Aerial delivers to MoKan by use of a third-party interexchange carrier such as SWB. Aerial traffic delivered to MoKan through SWB is indistinguishable from other toll traffic terminated by an interexchange carrier.

MoKan again requests that you pay the invoices sent. If you do not, MoKan will avail itself of any and all remedies available by tariff or by law.
