Early lifetime failures of wind projects have resulted in:

Liens being filed against landowners for materials and labor for construction on their property

Tax assessments being collected from the landowner when the wind contractor failed to pay

Costs for decommissioning partially finished wind projects assessed to the landowner.

A requirement that Grain Belt post an irrevocable bond in an amount sufficient to decommission the project at any time (not after 20 years) after the first shovel is put into the ground for the project is a reasonable requirement. If the prospects for Grain Belt are as positive as they present then the cost to Grain Belt to have a reliable financial institution back a decommissioning bond should not be a significant obligation on their part. In the absence of a decommissioning fund Missouri will have a profane monument 206 miles long if Grain Belt does not meet its obligations.

Page 15: "The Settlement Agreement states that the Commission should give its consent to Boards of County Commissioners of all Indiana counties to grant Petitioner such licenses, permits or franchises as may be necessary for Petitioner to occupy county roads, highways and other public rightsof-way for the provision of its services and facilities . . ."

Page 16: "Petitioner is not in a position to make an irrevocable commitment not to seek cost allocation."

Page 17: "Consequently, if all the qualifications for PJM or MISO regional cost sharing were met, costs associated with the Project could then be regionally allocated pursuant to a FERC-approved tariff through no action on the part of the Petitioner."

Page 20: figures are consistent with a capacity factor of 43% not the higher value in the Missouri Grain Belt application.
