**NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT  
AND CLOSING CASE**

Issue Date: November 2, 2006

On August 24, 2006, the Missouri Coalition for Fair Competition ("MCFFC") filed a formal complaint pursuant to Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070 against Laclede Gas Company. On August 30, the Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency advising MCFFC that its complaint was deficient for not having fully complied with Commission Regulations requiring the association be represented by an attorney authorized to practice law in the State of Missouri.

On November 1, 2006, prior to correcting the above noted deficiency, MCFFC filed a Notice of Dismissal stating that the deficiency in question was cured with the filing of a new case, GC-2007-0169, that will address the same or similar issues. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits a complainant to voluntarily dismiss its complaint without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral

evidence has been offered. No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that MCFFC has voluntarily dismissed its complaint. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission and this case may be closed.
