NOTICE OF COMPLAINT AND ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

On February 6, 2014, the Staff of the Commission filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Laclede Gas Company, d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy and Southern Union Company, formerly d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy. Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070, Laclede and Southern Union have 30 days from the date of this notice to file an answer. Since this notice is being issued on February 7, the thirty-day period will expire on Sunday March 9. That means their answers are due no later than Monday, March 10, 2014.

As required by Section 536.067(2)(f), RSMo 2000, the Commission informs the parties that the Commission's provisions governing procedures before the Commission, including provisions relating to discovery, are found at Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090.
