NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT
AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: December 15, 2006

On May 26, 2006, Andrew and Naomi Topps filed a complaint against Laclede Gas Company. Laclede filed its answer on June 30, 2006, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its report on October 6, 2006.

On December 14, 2006, prior to the filing of any testimony or the admission of any evidence, the Topps filed a Notice of Dismissal stating that all disputes between the parties have been resolved and that all parties of record had been served with a copy of their notice.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits a complainant to voluntarily dismiss its complaint without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered. No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that the Topps

have voluntarily dismissed their complaint. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission and this case may be closed.
