ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND DIRECTING FILING

On August 9, 2006,¹ Robert F. Morgan filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede"). Laclede filed its answer on September 11, and the Commission's Staff filed the report on its investigation into the complaint on October 12. A prehearing conference was held on October 23, and the parties were directed to jointly file a procedural schedule no later than October 30.

On October 27, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, with the agreement of the Complainant and Respondent, filed a report stating that the parties have tentatively reached a settlement and expect that a notice of dismissal will be filed within the next twenty days. Consequently, the Commission will suspend the requirement for the

filing of a procedural schedule and direct the parties to file the notice of dismissal or a status report by November 20.
