STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for this Staff Recommendation respectfully states as follows:

1. On February 24, 2023, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty ("Empire") filed tariff sheets (Tracking No. YE-2023-0166) for the Critical Medical Needs Program, which Empire agreed, pursuant to a stipulation and agreement in this case, to develop with the parties.

2. In addition, Empire requested the Commission allow the tariff sheets to become effective on an expedited basis, specifically, on March 6, 2023.

3. On February 27, 2023, the Commission issued its Order Directing an Expedited Tariff Recommendation, Setting Time for Responses and Directing Libiberty to File Substitute Tariff Sheets ("Order") in which it ordered Staff to file a recommendation regarding Empire's Critical Medical Needs Program tariff sheets no later than February 28, 2023, and further ordered Staff to explain why these tariff sheets should be approved on less than ten days' notice.

4. Empire filed substitute tariff sheets on February 27 and 28, 2023.

5. Staff has reviewed the tariff sheets and recommends that the Commission approve the following tariff sheets, filed on February 24, 2023, and as substituted on

February 27 and 28, 2023, to go into effect on an expedited basis on March 6, 2023, as requested by Empire:

2nd Revised Sheet No. 1 Canceling 1st Revised Sheet No. 1

P.S.C. Mo. No. 6 Sec. 4

Original Sheet No. 28

P.S.C. Mo. No. 6 Sec. 5

6. As for why these tariff sheets should be approved on less than ten days' notice, Staff submits that the Critical Medical Needs Program collaborative stakeholder group is supportive of expedited review and action on the proposed tariff sheets for Ameren Missouri, Liberty-Empire, and Spire Missouri in order to align timing of and approaches for consistency across the utilities for this program. To successfully administer and reduce confusion for eligible Missourians who will benefit from this program, participants should have a reasonable and consistent expectation of how the program works; in addition, it will assist in how the services are delivered by partners supporting the program effort. The United Way of Greater St. Louis and Southwest Missouri will administer this program and is in the process of launching the program on April 1st. Approval of these tariff sheets on less than ten days' notice helps to support a seamless rollout and implementation of this program by April 1st.

6. This pleading is verified by the affidavit of Mr. Brad Fortson, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREFORE Staff recommends the Commission issue an order approving the tariff sheets, filed on February 24, 2023, and as substituted on February 27 and 28, 2023, to go into effect on an expedited basis on March 6, 2023, as requested by Empire, and granting such other and further relief as the Commission deems appropriate:
