**ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFF SHEETS**

Issue Date: December 27, 2012

Effective Date: January 2, 2013

On December 12, 2012, the Commission issued a report and order that rejected Ameren Missouri's tariff to increase the company's annual revenues from its provision of electric service. However, the Commission authorized Ameren Missouri to file a tariff sufficient to recover revenues as determined in that report and order. Ameren Missouri filed its compliance tariff on December 17.

Ameren Missouri's compliance tariff carries a 30-day effective date that would put the tariff in effect on January 16, 2013. However, Ameren Missouri filed a motion along with its tariff asking the Commission to expedited its consideration of the compliance tariff and to approve the tariff to go into effect on January 2, 2013, which is the date to which the Commission suspended Ameren Missouri's initial rate increase tariff.

Upon receiving Ameren Missouri's motion for expedited approval of its tariff, the Commission issued an order on December 17, directing its Staff to file a recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff by December 24. That order also directed any other

party wishing to file a recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's tariff to do so no later than December 24.

On December 21, the Commission's Staff filed its recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri's compliance tariff and motion for expedited treatment. Staff concludes the tariff complies with the Commission's report and order, and recommends the Commission approve the compliance tariff to be effective on January 2. No other party filed a recommendation and no party has filed a response to Staff's recommendation.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff and Staff's recommendation. The Commission concludes the submitted compliance tariff is consistent with the Commission's Report and Order. Expedited approval of the tariff is appropriate because the Commission has found that the rates resulting from its report and order are just and reasonable and Ameren Missouri should not be required to wait to implement those rates. Thus, for good cause shown pursuant to Section 393.140(11), RSMo 2000, The Commission will approve Ameren Missouri's tariff to become effective for service rendered on and after January 2, 2013.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The proposed electric service tariff submitted under Tariff No. YE-2013-0269 by Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, is approved effective on and after January 2, 2013. The specific tariff sheets approved are:
