## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SHORTENING TIME FOR RESPONSES

On December 7, 2020, Consumers Council of Missouri filed its *Motion for an Emergency Order and Request for Expedited Treatment* requesting the Commission issue a statewide moratorium on the involuntary disconnection or discontinuance of residential service by Commission-regulated electric, gas, and water corporations through at least March 31, 2021. The motion also requests the Commission order the waiver of any late fees and related costs. The motion states that these measures are necessary to protect the health and welfare of the public during the Covid-19 pandemic. Consumers Council requests that the Commission take action by December 16, 2020.

The Commission will direct notice of this motion and shorten the time for responses.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Responses to Consumers Council's motion for a disconnection moratorium and request for expedited treatment shall be filed no later than December 14, 2020.
- 2. The Commission's data center shall provide a copy of this order to all Missouri investor-owned electric, gas, water, and sewer utilities.

- 3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the Missouri General Assembly, and to the news media serving the state of Missouri.
  - 4. This order shall be effective when issued.
